



## WHAT THE HYVE MODEL IS ABOUT

The Hyve model consists of an early childhood education and care plan discussion at the daycare and health examinations by a public health nurse and a doctor.



The Hyve model helps improve the well-being of families with children, helps improve co-operation between parents and the daycare staff and the child health clinic staff, and, where needed, offers timely support.


# The Hyve model

# How the Hyve model works



The daycare staff go through the feedback received from the child health clinic. Where necessary, the daycare and the parents meet to discuss how to help and support the child in daily life. The agreed upon measures are recorded in the child's early childhood education and care plan.

Please make an appointment for an early childhood education and care plan discussion (VASU) with the daycare staff before your child's 4th birthday.

Make an appointment for a 4-year health examination with the public health nurse, keeping in mind that the examination should be no sooner than two weeks after the VASU discussion. You will also receive information about other materials for mapping the family's well-being.

Do not book a doctor's appointment until after the nurses health examination.

The daycare staff will give you materials with information on Hyve.

After reading the materials, consider things that have to do with your child's growth and development before the VASU discussion at the daycare.

The daycare staff, too, observe the child in different everyday situations and record information about his/her growth and development.

At the VASU discussion, the parents and the daycare staff discuss the child's growth and development. They also agree upon what information and questions the daycare will forward to the child health clinic.

The public health nurse will prepare for the examination by reading the summary of the child's VASU discussion sent by daycare.

For the child, the 4-year examination is a play-like session where the nurse evaluates the child's growth and development. The examination also covers the child's neurological development. The nurse and the parents also discuss the entire family's well-being and agree upon what information will be sent to the daycare.

The doctor studies the daycare staff's summary and the nurse's observations of the child. The doctor performs a general examination of the child and evaluates his/her overall development.

Where needed, the doctor or nurse can give a referral for further examinations. With the parents' permission, the daycare can be notified about the referrals.
